

The Christmas Offering of Ministry for Change this year is for our local partner agency HCS Family Services. HCS Family Services is a compassionate not-for-profit organization which has been serving 360 neighbors weekly in need since 1937. Their work is to prevent food insecurity and create an improved quality of life for the people we serve and their families.

As a nonprofit, HCS Family Services is dependent upon the generosity of food and financial donations and the manpower of more than 400 volunteers to support its mission. Last year, local retail partners donated 400,000+ pounds of food through the Food Rescue program to stock the food pantries. There are many opportunities to volunteer during the week on the website.

For every \$1.00 donation the pantry can purchase \$8 in groceries. Please give generously to help the families who need food support. Also, paper and plastic grocery bags are collected in the bin inside the north entrance.

For both online or check, if you want to split amounts between the church and HCS Family Services, just put that in the memo line on the giving page or on the check.

SUNDAY SCHOOL

There is always Sunday School and nursery care for children five and under in classroom 129 on the lower level.

We won't have Sunday school today for elementary school children, since so many of them are already in the pageant! As always, we welcome children & their joyful energy in our worship services whether in the pageant or the pews. You may ask the ushers for a red activity bag & feel free to use the Narthex (through the glass doors under the balcony) for extra space if you/your child wants to move around during service.

RESTROOMS

To find the gender-neutral restroom, exit through the main doors of the Sanctuary into The Gathering Place. Follow the glass doors on your left until a hallway opens on your left. It is a few steps down that hallway on your right.

We also have larger gendered restrooms through the main doors and to your right, off The Gathering Space – complete with changing tables on the lower and main levels.

UNION CHURCH EARLY CHILDHOOD INITIATIVE - WHAT IS THE LATEST WITH OUR SUMMIT PROJECT?

The UCECI team has continued to work diligently as we seek to secure a location for a quality full day preschool in Summit. We have identified a potential building available for purchase in Summit. An initial environmental inspection has been completed on the property. Considerable work has been done to examine the financial feasibility of the site and to investigate a possible property tax exemption. We continue to research the feasibility of the property from a business perspective to ensure the preschool would succeed. Completion of this work will determine the possibility of seeking congregational approval prior to submitting an offer to purchase the property. We look forward to sharing more information with you at a future date.

OFFICE HOLIDAY HOURS



A GREAT WAY TO GIVE: GIFTING APPRECIATED STOCK

Making a gift of appreciated stock can be a great way to support the church financially, either to fulfill your "pledge" for the year, or to make an additional donation. The benefits to the member include avoiding capital gain taxes, getting a charitable deduction based on the fair market value of the stock on the day of the gift, and satisfying pledges or making donations without any out-of-pocket cash payments.
