What is Christian Community? What makes us different from other community organizations-the PTO, Rotary, a country club?

• Follow Jesus' teachings, family, called to action, principles, support for all, multi-generational, hierarchy: faithful community-Christian-UCC, safe always- but also challenging!

What does love look like in a Christian Community?

• Care, accepting, unconditional, Agape, benefit all, selfless giving, non-judgmental, inclusive, respectful, give back with purpose, walk the talk, grow, share God's creation, discernment vs. critical judgement

What does it mean to be lay led vs. clergy led?

- Not always easy to discern!
- Lay Led: Partnership, collaborative, funnel down from the members to clergy, church family sets tone for congregation, decision making = congregational
- Clergy Led: Spiritual guide, faith forward, decision making = clergy is authority

What does all the above mean for Union Church in the future, say in 2035?

evolve dynamically, grow, ADAPT, weeknight service?, inclusive, accepting, interfaith, do less-but do well
