UNION CHURCH MEN'S SOFTBALL WEEKLY RECAP



This past Wednesday's match-up against the 'The Peacemakers' was a barn burner! In our closest game yet, the Hellfire fell just short with a final score of 12-17, with 9 runs scored in the final inning before the game was called for time.

Luke Cote returned from a shoulder injury this week and successfully leveraged his experience in college baseball to really set the team up for success. Following a rough first inning, Cote instituted some personnel changes to better capitalize on the team's strengths, resulting in much stronger defensive production. When reached for comment, he said "Well, our goal this week was to score more than 10 runs and keep our opponent to under 20. And we did both those things, with only 9

guys no less, so we feel pretty good about that. We're building a program here, and that takes time. Fostering a culture of winning doesn't happen overnight, but I'm confident we're headed in the right direction."

Player highlights included great offensive production from Colin Dowling and Sam Scaletta (returning from a knee injury), Michael Ott turning 2 double plays at second base, and Chris Weil (in his debut for the season) catching a flyball in left then throwing a frozen rope to first to pick off the runner who didn't tag up. Special thanks to Diane and Virgil Oostendorp for being the first fans not directly related to a player to attend a game!

Next week's game on 7/16 is a rematch against York Tavern at 8:30 pm at Veeck Park.
