Our building is 98% LED lighting


1 industrial kitchen and 4 kitchenettes

Qualified Charitable Distributions A Tax-Smart Way to Support Union Church

What is a QCD?

A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is a direct transfer of funds from your IRA to an eligible charity. If you are 70½ or older, a QCD allows you to make tax-free donations, even if you don't itemize deductions.

Key benefits

- Reduce your taxable income. By donating directly from your IRA, the distribution is excluded from your taxable income, which can lower your Adjusted Gross Income (AGI).
- Satisfy your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD). For those aged 73 and older, a QCD can count toward your RMD for the year.
- Lower Medicare premiums. Reducing your AGI may help lower your Medicare premiums.
- **Give without itemizing:** Since the gift is a tax-free distribution, you get the full tax benefit of your donation even if you don't itemize deductions.
- Make a larger gift: By using your IRA, you can turn otherwise taxable funds into a powerful, taxfree gift that benefits Union Church.

Important details

- **Eligibility:** You must be 70½ or older at the time of the distribution.
- Limit: The annual limit for QCDs is \$108,000 per person in 2025.
- **Direct transfer is required:** The funds must be transferred directly from your IRA administrator to the charity. You cannot withdraw the money yourself first.

How to get started

Contact your IRA administrator to initiate a direct transfer to Union Church. It's a simple process that can maximize your giving and your tax benefits.

Advent Book Discussion


Join Rev. Tim Rhodes every Sunday evening in Advent via Zoom for a discussion on the book The First Christmas.

Join Dr. Emily Rogalski of the SuperAging Research Initiative and our own Union Church super ager, June Scott, to learn more about this positive and proactive approach to understanding aging.

The University of Chicago is a leading institution in SuperAging research, focusing on individuals over 80 with exceptional memory performance.

The SuperAging Research Initiative, led by <u>Dr. Emily Rogalski</u>, studies these individuals to identify factors that contribute to healthy cognitive aging and potentially prevent or delay Alzheimer's disease.

In essence, the SuperAging research at UChicago is a positive and proactive approach to understanding aging, with the potential to benefit not just individuals but also society as a whole.
