GENEROSITY CORNER

UNABASHED GRATITUDE

In the third week of our Unabashed Gratitude series, we focus on The Ministry for Change which is led by James Roeschlein.

Every month The Ministry for Change partners with DuPage PADS to feed over 250 guests who are homeless at the interim housing center in Downers Grove.

DuPage County is one of the wealthiest counties in Illinois, but it is also home to the second largest food insecure population in the state. Hinsdale Community Services Family Services provides over 500,000 meals to mean women and children at risk of hunger in our community. They assist over 400 people each week.

Below are upcoming opportunities to show our Unabashed Gratitude by sharing what God has given us with those who are less fortunate.

- Humboldt Park Soup Kitchen meets weekly in the church kitchen to cook and then deliver the soup to area churches
- Church members prepare food on the 4th Tuesday evening of the month at DuPage PADS shelter for the homeless in Downers Grove
- Dec 21st @ 11:15a the Night Ministry's will make sandwiches and provide approximately 150 sack lunches monthly to children and families in need. This recurs every 3rd Sunday and it's a commitment of less than 2hrs.
- Eleanor's Stocking stuffs stockings with winter items such as gloves and caps for our neighbors in need on Sunday, December 7th after both the 9am and 10am services
- Bring in mittens, scarves, and gloves to benefit the children of our Mission Ministries, Nov 30, 2025 Jan 6,2026.

THE NIGHT MINISTRY

For our Thanksgiving Offering this year, we encourage you to make a special contribution to our Ministry for Change partner, The Night Ministry of Chicago.

Homelessness and poverty can be incredibly isolating and lonely experiences. The Night Ministry works to address these needs by providing youth engagement Services, working to meet and build relationships with youth and young adults experiencing homelessness.

Union Church been a long-term supporter of The Night Ministry, both giving monetary support, and providing sandwiches for distribution monthly. The need is elevated now because recent government funding cuts will reduce the Ministry's ability to purchase and distribute food. In addition, many of the Ministry's clients depend on SNAP benefits for nutritional support, and these benefits are also being cut
